Undergraduates (BFA, BA candidates) may declare a major upon matriculation and at the latest, by the completion of 30 credits at SFAI. BFA candidates can declare a second studio major. A change of major or adding a second major may require completing courses beyond the 120 semester credit minimum in order to satisfy requirements for the new major. MFA candidates may declare or change an emphasis upon matriculation and at the latest, before their last term towards completing degree requirements. BFA minor requirements are listed at the back of this form.
